THIS WEEK: It's Bastille Day, so I've chosen the only work for unaccompanied choir by French composer Claude Debussy. In 1909 he published *Trois Chansons* (Three Songs), settings of medieval poetry by Charles, Duke of Orléans (1394-1465). This is the third, *Yver, vous n'êtes qu'un vilain* (Winter, you're just a rogue) which denounces winter, especially compared with the warmth and gentleness of summer.
